

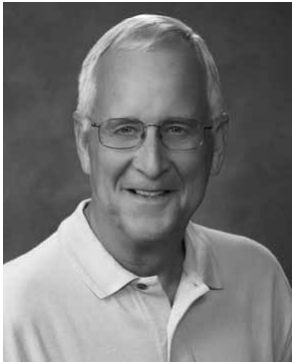
Pinellas Library Cooperative Welcomes New Board Members

The Pinellas Public Library Cooperative is pleased to announce its newly elected and appointed Board members for the 2012 – 2013 fiscal year. The Cooperative welcomes elected members John Doran of Clearwater and Gary Lewis of Oldsmar to their new Board positions. Additionally, we are pleased to have Cecilia Burke, resident of the Seminole-Largo area of unincorporated Pinellas County, fill the At-Large District 2 seat appointed by the Pinellas Board of County Commissioners. Mr. Doran, a resident of Clearwater, is an active member of the community serving in many capacities. Mr. Doran recently completed his term as a City Council Member and served as the city representative on the Downtown Development

Mr. Doran's educational background includes a Masters degree in Business Administration and a Juris Doctorate. Mr. Doran brings his skills as an attorney and a CPA in addition to his long-term commitment to his community to his position on the Board.

Mr. Lewis, a resident of Oldsmar, served in the U.S. Coast Guard for twenty-six years. He was the supply officer on three of the United States Coast Guard's largest ships. In addition to his professional successes, Mr. Lewis has served as the President as well as the Secretary/Treasurer of his homeowners association. Since retirement, Mr. Lewis has been an active volunteer in his community. He was recognized as the 2010 Volunteer of the Year by the Oldsmar Public Library. Mr. Lewis is an asset to the Board and will bring a unique vision to library service in Pinellas County. Mrs. Burke, a resident of the Seminole-Largo area of unincorporated Pinellas County, was appointed the Board of County Commissioners At-Large District 2 representative. A graduate of Leadership St. Pete, she served eight years as Governor Bush's appointment to the Juvenile Welfare Board, was chairman of the Pinellas County Childcare Licensing Board, and held leadership positions with Oakhurst Elementary PTA and St. Petersburg Collegiate High PSTA. For several years she was active with the Pinellas County homeschool community; a group of avid library users. Cecilia's prior career included campaign manager for education advocate State Senator Don Sullivan; committee staff for Congressman Dan Burton; and executive director of the Deerfield Beach Chamber of Commerce, at which time she was recognized as Deerfield Beach's Woman of the Year.

He is known throughout the Tampa Bay area for his numerous donations and volunteering spirit. From being a "2008 Yerrid's Hero" (through the Tampa Bay Lightning organization), to volunteering at the Ronald McDonald House in St. Petersburg, the Fish Broil on Pass-A-Grille, and here at the library. Tucker the Reading Therapy Dog has given billions of smiles, untold comfort, and the courage to read aloud to people of every age. Tucker first came to the St. Pete Beach Public Library in 2006; he was an instant "hit." His program here focused on reading skills and enabling children to read aloud to both family and total strangers when they were shy and uncertain. Tucker gave self confidence to those young readers while giving their caregivers a peek at that confidence in the first stage of the growing excitement of 'I read it myself!'

Tucker not only helped the children and astounded the caregivers; he delighted the rest of the library staff and patrons alike. He is so much a part of us that in 2009 at the funeral of our past library director, Roberta L. Whipple, he came to the service and gave comfort.

Tucker was very excited in April, three years ago, when at the age of 10 he became a father of five boys, three of whom still 'live at home'! Tucker is an indispensable part of our library family history now; he mentored so many new readers, so many moments of delight, so much good in one furry, wiggly package. We were so very lucky that day in 2006 when Kathleen asked if I'd heard of Therapy Dogs; lucky to have known Tucker and his family! Ranger, Skeeter, Parker and their mom, Paige along with their humans, Kathleen & Jim, have our most heart-felt sympathy for their loss.

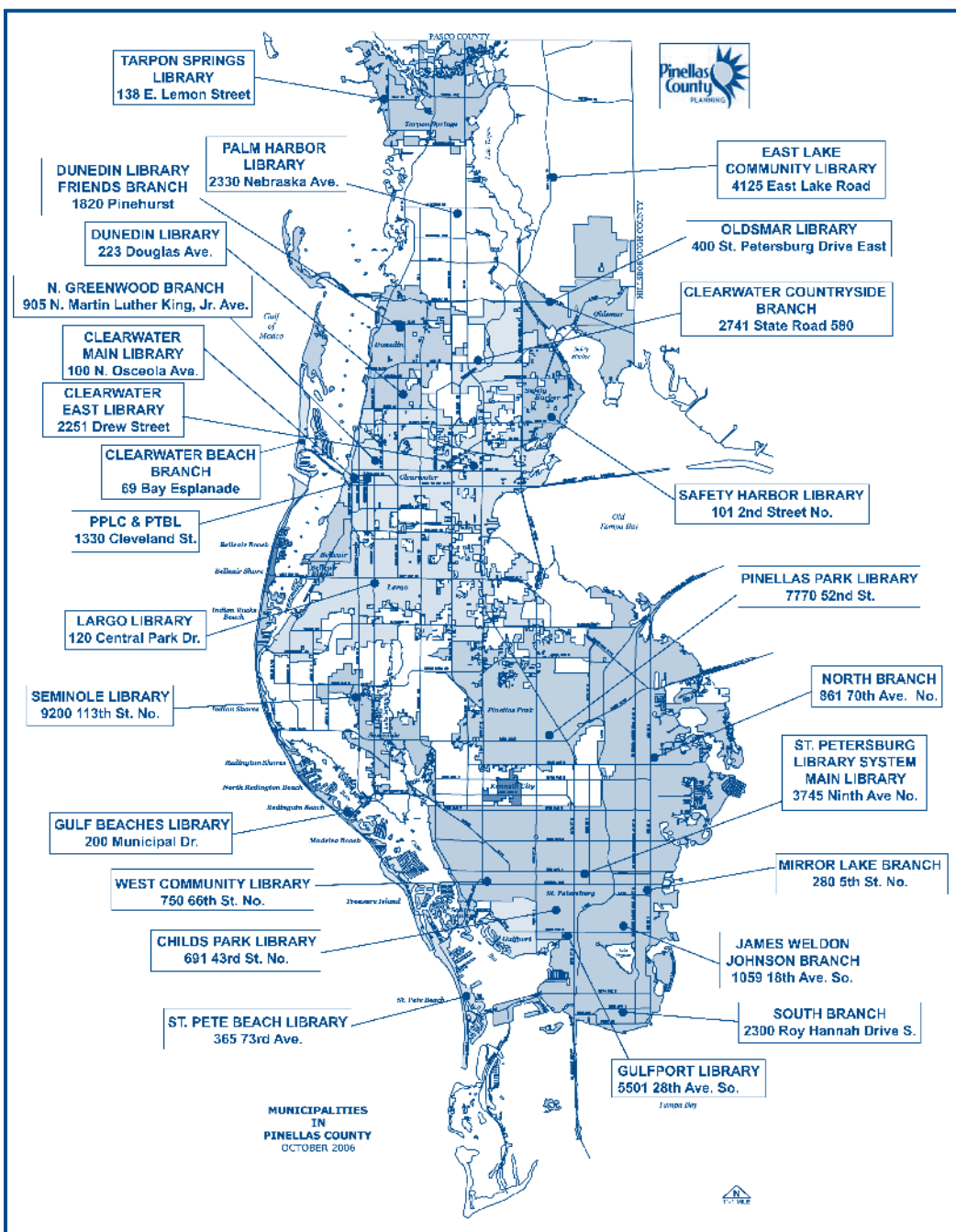
