Gulfport Library - The Gulfport library has a new library administrator, David Mather. David has an M.A. in American History from Villanova University and an M.S. in Library and Information Science

from Drexel University. Prior to working in Gulfport he worked as a Circulation Supervisor at the Phoenixville Public Library in Phoenixville Pennsylvania; part of the Chester County Library System. He then moved to Florida with his family to pursue his career as a Librarian in the Pasco County Library System. While in Pasco, David worked as a reference librarian and teen librarian at various locations and as the

branch manager of the South Holiday Library. Most recently, he worked as a library administrator, part of Pasco County Library's three member Library Leadership Team which shares responsibility for overseeing the seven branch library system.

When asked why he chose to work at Gulfport David explained, "I loved working in Pasco County, but I really like the opportunities one has working in a city library." "Gulfport is such a great city with lots of character and I am really excited to partner with other community leaders as well as the other libraries in the cooperative." He also plans to add more programming for all ages, e-government services and a healthy balance between traditional library services and the need to remain technologically innovative. "I think the most important aspect of a library is to add value to the community by responding to the needs of the City's residents and offer those residents exceptional customer service." "If I am not out on the desk, my door will always be open to speak to members of the community and listen to their ideas on how to make the Gulfport Library even better."

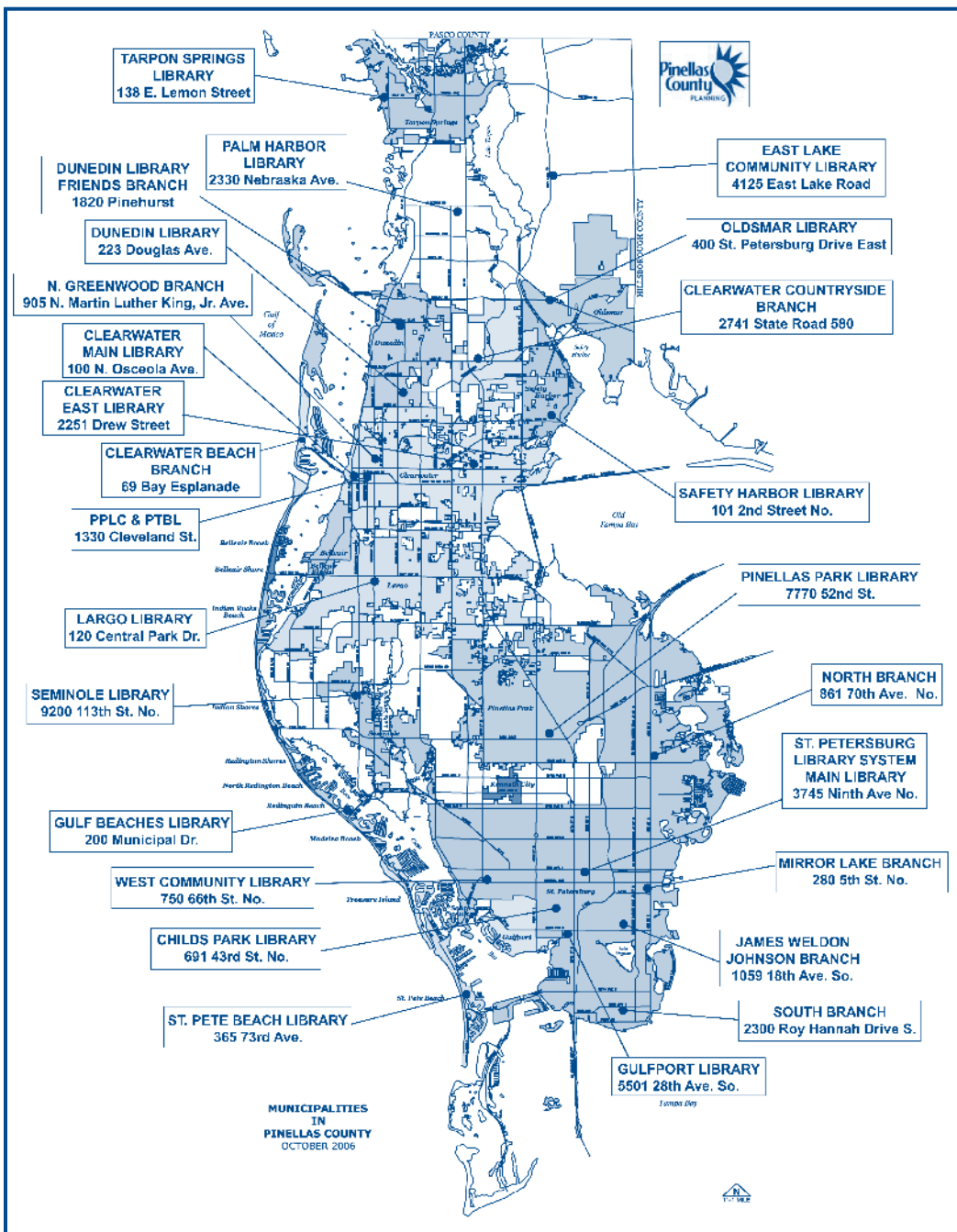
