Reading With The RAYS: Read your way to the ballpark at YOUR Library this summer!

With baseball season and summer in full swing, the *Tampa Bay Times* Newspaper in Education department has again partnered with the Tampa Bay Rays, Suncoast Credit Union and the public libraries in Pinellas County for a fun and exciting summer.

The Reading with the Rays program will encourage you to read more this summer and to visit the library regularly before you return to school in August. By reading books this summer students in can circle the bases – first, second, third and home – and collect prizes as they go.

Make it all the way around to home and your ultimate reward is two tickets to see the Rays in action at Tropicana field!

The rules of the Read Your Way to the Ballpark Game are simple.

- Get your game card at your library.
- Go to your local library to get your game card.
- Choose your favorite books from your local library or select your favorite section of the *Tampa Bay Times* to read over the summer.

- As you read, track your hours by rounding the bases and collect Rays rewards along the way.
- When you read enough hours to get to first base, ask your parent or guardian to initial your card; then bring it to your local library.
- The librarian will initial your card and give you a reading reward.
- Round the bases by reading a total of 24 hours this summer and receive a certificate of completion signed by Evan Longoria and two tickets to a Rays game!
- Although this program is focused on students in grades 3 through 5, all students in grades Pre-K through 12 can participate.

When you read enough hours to get on first base, ask your parent or guardian to initial your card, then bring it to your local library. The librarian will initial your card and give you a reading reward.

KEEPING SCORE: On the back of the card, keep track of your favorite books and articles you read this summer. **Read around the bases – 24 hours total!**

Read 3 hours to get from Home Plate to First Base **Reward:** Reading with the Rays poster featuring Evan Longoria

Read 5 more hours to get from First to Second Base **Reward:** Reading with the Rays jelly bracelet

Read 7 more hours to get from Second to Third Base **Reward:** Reading with the Rays sunglasses

Read 9 more hours to get from Third Base to Home Plate **Reward:** Reading with the Rays certificate authorized by Evan Longoria and voucher redeemable for two complimentary tickets to a 2015 Rays regular season home game (select dates and restrictions apply).

In order to receive your two (2) free Rays upper deck tickets: Bring your completed game card to the Tropicana Field box office. In order to receive the desired game and seat location, it is best to redeem this card prior to the day of game.

The Rays are excited about this summer reading program. To see what Evan Longoria, Chris Archer, Matt Moore, Renee Rivera, Kevin Cash and, of course, Raymond and DJ Kitty have to say about reading, be sure to get your copy of Reading with the Rays: Read your way to the ballpark, which will be in your *Tampa Bay Times* newspaper on Sunday, June 8.
