If you're thinking about improving your health as 2016 begins, Pinellas Public Library Cooperative (PPLC) member libraries can give you the support you need to achieve results. Libraries have a long history of meeting the demand for consumer health information, nutrition, and exercise. There are many ways for patrons to utilize library resources to start the New Year feeling great.

Library computers are often used to research health and wellness issues. All PPLC libraries provide access to the Internet via computers or through wireless service that allows users to bring their own devices to search for information. Library staff is available to guide patrons in the use of databases such as the online Health and Wellness Resource Center and in web searches for reputable health sites and medical resources.

Health literacy and awareness are an important part of a community's information needs. PPLC libraries materials collections include books,

audio books, magazines, and DVDs. Subject areas such as, nutrition, diet, exercise, organic gardening, just to name a few, help keep resolutions on track.

Library events and classes play an important role in improving health literacy too.
