In celebration, PPLC highlights the powerful positive impact its member libraries are making in the lives of Pinellas County children, adults, and families. Promoting literacy among children, adults, and families is an important function of Pinellas County Public Libraries.

It is not only the vast collections of reading materials in many formats that libraries provide, but the classes, events, and regular program opportunities that are offered. Whether a pre-school story time, English as a Second Language (ESL or ESOL) class, or Sign Language class. PPLC member libraries are enthusiastic promoters of enhancing literacy and learning for all ages in YOUR community.

Pinellas County Public Libraries are also partnering with literacy councils, such as the St. Petersburg Library System's Mirror Lake





Community Library which opened their newly formed Literacy Center last month. Working together with the Literacy Council of St. Petersburg, the St. Petersburg Public Library System's center at the Mirror Lake branch will soon be a hub of activity for Adult Learners. We have seen evidence of the model program in the Dunedin Public Library, who partners with the

Literacy Council of Upper Pinellas (LCUP). Additionally, the Largo, Seminole and Palm Harbor Public Libraries have thriving adult literacy programs for English language learners. In fact, all PPLC Member Libraries have programs tailored to meet the needs of each community. Also recently launched in Pinellas County is the Career Online High School, an alternative path to a high school degree. By partnering with Florida's Division of Library and Information Services, Pinellas County Public Libraries now offer an online program where successful students earn accredited high school diplomas and career certificates.
