## Unearth Your Family Tree at Your Public Library

Have you ever been curious about your family's history? About the lives your ancestors led? Where they lived and what they did for a living? Genealogy is the study of family lineages and histories. Genealogy research is the pursuit of one's family history and origins. It can provide context for your own personal family in a larger historical picture, works to preserve the past for future generations, and can provide self-satisfaction in using research to tell your family's story. Genealogy is different things to different people. There are several practical reasons why people research their family histories: tracing inheritances, verifying family stories, and gaining a personal connection to historical events. At its core genealogy is about human curiosity. We all question where we come from, why we are here, and what will happen to our own stories after we are gone. Genealogy helps personalize history and aids us in understanding how we, as individuals, fit into the past, present, and future.

Researching your family history is now easier than ever with access to online records that are easily searchable. In Pinellas County, library card holders can access the popular genealogy website, Ancestry, at their local public library for free. Ancestry allows patrons to search and view several records that are used in genealogy research such as vital records, census records, military records, and immigration documents. Don't know where to start? That's okay! Several public libraries in Pinellas County offer genealogy help as well as programs and classes to help you get started. Several of these programs and classes are listed in this program guide under Adult Classes. If you are interested in local history, you can browse the Pinellas Memory Project (<http://pinellasmemory.contentdm.oclc.org>) and the Florida Memory Project (<https://www.floridamemory.com/>) to access digitized historical archives. **Happy researching!**
