Summer BreakSpots: *Friends-Food-Free all summer long at Pinellas County Libraries*

During the summer break from school, several PPLC member libraries have partnered with Pinellas County Schools (PCS) and the Juvenile Welfare Board (JWB), and will be serving free lunches to kids and teens. "Summer BreakSpot" sites provide free, nutritious meals to kids and teens under the age of 18 from May 31st to July 28th. There is no need to apply, and children can visit Summer Breakspot sites at the following libraries during summer break for a free lunch: The Clearwater Main Library, Oldsmar Public Library, Pinellas Park's Barbara S. Ponce Library, and the St. Petersburg Main Library. In addition to a free nutritious lunch, children can also take part in the many free summer reading programs offered by their library!

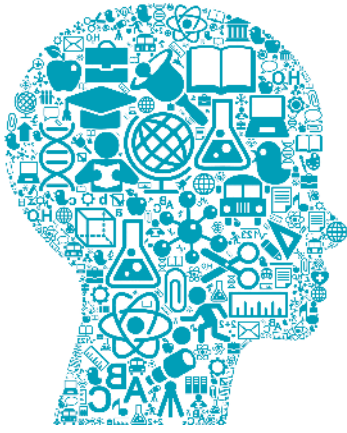
