A New Museum Pass Partner

An exciting new partnership with the Florida Holocaust Museum is bringing even more free museum options to the popular museum pass program! PPLC library cardholders can now check out a museum pass to the Florida Holocaust Museum (FHM) in St. Petersburg. One of the largest Holocaust museums in the United States the FHM's mission is to honor the memory of the millions of lives who suffered and were lost in the Holocaust. Visitors to FHM will find three floors of temporary and permanent exhibits with original artifacts, photographs and documents, with a special emphasis on local survivors.

HOW THE MUSEUM PASS WORKS:

- Each PPLC member library and its branches will have two museum passes.
- Passes are available for checkout on a first-come, first-served basis.
- You may check the availability of passes on the PPLC online catalog or by contacting your library's circulation staff.
- Present the receipt from the library to the FHM staff upon entry. FHM will retain the receipt.
- Admission is valid for up to 2 adults and three children under the age of 18, in the same household.
- There is a checkout limit of one

- pass per family. Passes may be checked out by adult cardholders.
- Passes are valid for one visit within the 7-day loan period.

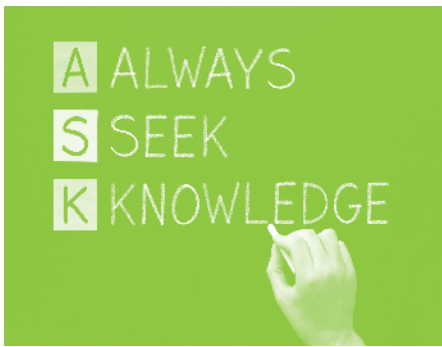
