The bright blue building is home to hundreds of pieces of American Studio Glass pieces and represents over 55 artists over 55 years.

The museum's impressive collection highlights the development of Contemporary American Studio Glass as a fine art form. Visitors to the Imagine Museum will walk through exhibits that display majors works of American art by founding, leading, current and emerging artists

> allows for FREE family admission to the collection for up to 2 adults, and 3 children. The Imagine Museum joins four other partners in the museum pass program including: the Chihuly Collection, the Florida Holocaust Museum, the Great Explorations Children's Museum, and the Museum of Fine Arts.

How the museum pass works

- Each PPLC member library and its branches have two museum passes from each museum partner.
- Passes are available for checkout on a first-come, first-served basis.
- You may check the availability of passes by contacting your library's circulation staff.
- Present the receipt from the library to museum staff upon entry. The museum will retain your receipt.
- Admission is valid for up to 2 adults, and three children under the age of 18, in the same household.
- There is a checkout limit of one pass per family. Passes may be checked out by adult cardholders.
- Passes are valid for one visit within the 7-day loan period.


