Have you ever wanted to learn how to play the ukulele, piano or the guitar? Or wanted to practice the ukulele after participating in the free ukulele workshops hosted by Pinellas Public libraries? All Pinellas Public Library Cooperative (PPLC) cardholders now have access to free online music and art lessons through a new resource called ArtistWorks. ArtistWorks provides patrons with world-class music, voice, and art instruction through self-paced video lessons taught by highly accomplished and Grammy Award-winning music and art professionals.

ArtistWorks offers 24 instrumental, voice and fine-arts classes, from basic courses to intermediate instruction to advanced lessons suitable for both youth and adults. ArtistWorks is

accessible on desktops and mobile devices, meaning patrons can enjoy on-the-go learning 24/7.
